Goal: To empower every Bahamian voter with the tools to evaluate political parties on the issues that actually affect their lives. Use the tracker below to objectively assess each party vying to lead our next administration and decide for yourself who has truly earned your vote.

How to use this tool:

Step 1: Pick a question from the tracker that matters to you, or ask your own.

Step 2: Research each party's stance and paste a credible source to back it up.

Step 3: Rate their position using this scale: 1 = No stance or no publicly available credible information on the issue, 2 = Vague or general statement, no real detail, 3 = Partial plan, but missing key specifics, 4 = Clear plan with concrete commitments, 5 = Detailed, costed, and someone is held accountable for delivery

Step 4: Write your honest thoughts and the conclusions you came to in the notes box.

Suggested Questions: Not sure where to start? You're not alone, analyzing political campaigns can feel overwhelming at first. Credible Sources: A credible source is any piece of information that is trustworthy, accurate, and backed by evidence. It typically comes from authors or institutions with expertise, uses verifiable data, and is transparent about where its information comes from. Credible sources are important because they help you form informed opinions, avoid misinformation, and make sound decisions, especially when analyzing issues like political campaigns or public policy. You can usually recognize a credible source by its reputation, use of facts and citations, balanced perspective, and accountability to the public.
